Family exchanges are what town twinning is all about and Letchworth has very long standing connections with Wissen in the Westerwald, an hour east of Cologne, Germany, and Chagny in Burgundy, south of Dijon, France.

Wissen will be coming to us from **5th to 9th May** and we're planning a programme of excursions and events, for an expected busload of visitors, including an afternoon and evening in London, for visitors and hosts. However, as always, the important element in town twinning is the family or individual who hosts the incoming visitors and makes them feel thoroughly at home. Letchworth will be travelling to Chagny **Thursday 18th to Monday 22nd August** and the French committee have a great plan in place for us, including the Royal Salt Works at Arc-et-Senans, a World Heritage Site. We'll be going by luxury coach, as usual, and, although this takes most of the day, the journey is made enjoyable by a two hour Channel crossing with opportunity for a long breakfast and some "duty-free" shopping and an hour long lunch break near Reims. Also a further shorter break. These days we don't fill the bus so there's plenty of room for the passengers. The fare this year will be £150 for adults, £50 for children and £50 each for travellers using their own vehicle, which is to cover their share of use of the coach while in Chagny.
